SB 414 addresses the managerial, financial and technical issues of failing water systems, without the need of a statewide water tax.

SB 414 (CABALLERO) THE SMALL SYSTEM WATER AUTHORITY ACT OF 2019



PERMANENT AND SUSTAINABLE COMPLIANCE

One-time investment from the general fund surplus, applied over four years.



LOCAL CONTROL

Establishes agencies with a locally-elected boards of directors.



TRANSPARENCY

Open and public meetings, audits and finances posted on a public website.



FINANCIAL CAPACITY

More ratepayers to share the cost of compliance, resulting in equitable rates.

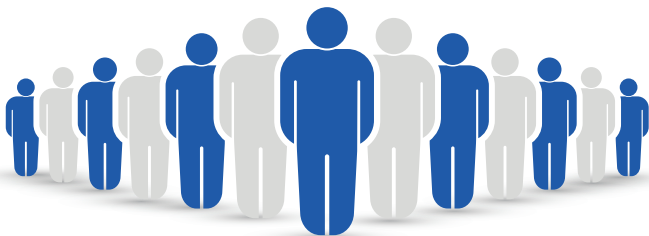
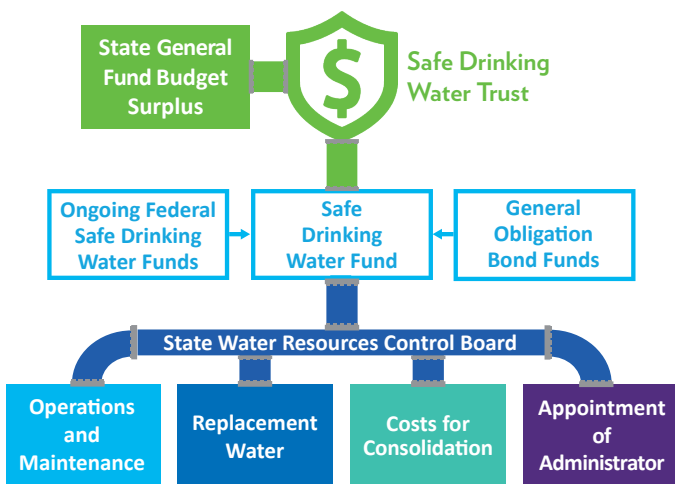
