PROJECT BACKGROUND

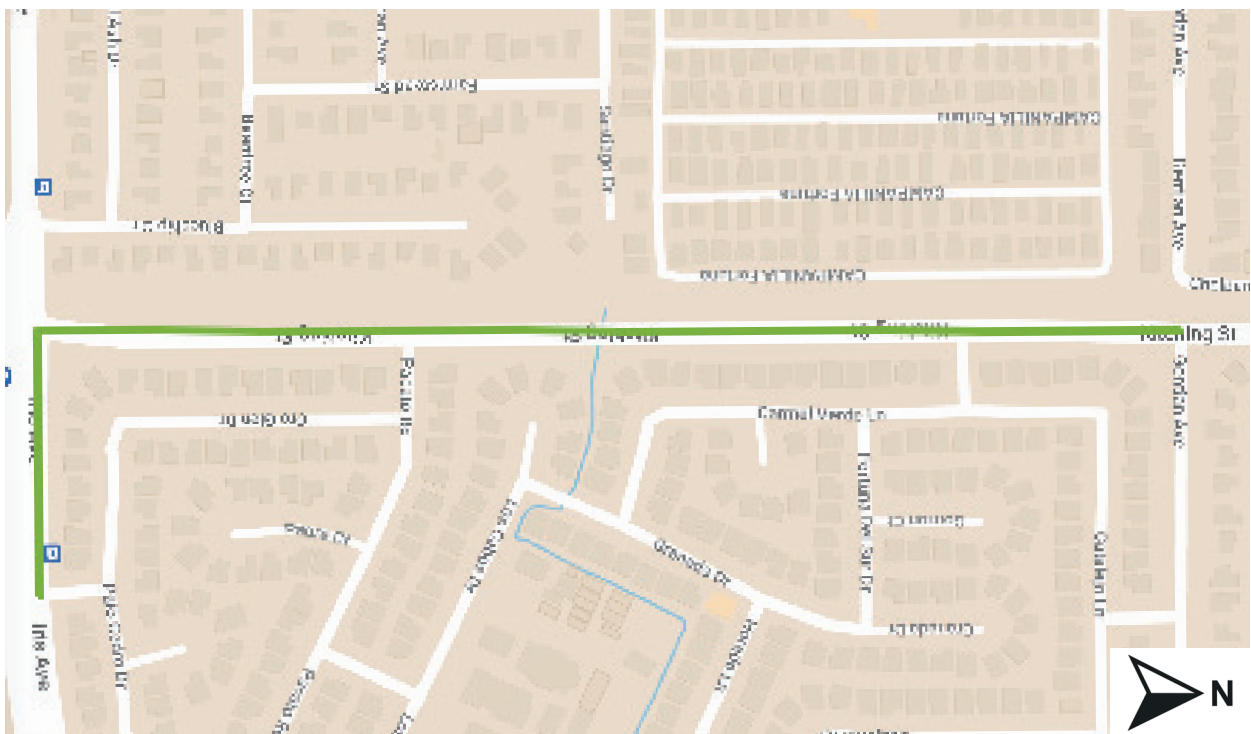
The City of Moreno Valley is home to some of Eastern Municipal Water District's earliest water and sewer infrastructure. As one of the fastest growing cities in the state, the City of Moreno Valley is dependent on safe and reliable water and wastewater services to accommodate its growing population.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In the Winter of 2023/24, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) will begin work on the Kitching Street and Iris Avenue Sewer Pipeline Replacement Project (Project). The purpose of the Project is to upgrade existing sewer pipeline with larger diameter pipe, to accommodate growth in the City of Moreno Valley. The estimated completion date is Fall 2024.

The Project consists of installing approximately 3,500 feet of sewer pipeline along Kitching Street from Gentian Avenue to Iris Avenue and along Iris Avenue from Kitching Street to La Fortuna Lane.

PROJECT IMPACTS / WHAT TO EXPECT

- There are no water and wastewater shutdowns anticipated throughout the duration of the Project.
- The community can expect work between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. although actual construction hours will vary throughout the scope of the Project. While the majority of the work will be done during the day, set working hours will vary to accommodate school schedules and higher traffic levels.
- Traffic control measures will be in place. Traffic control plans are reviewed and approved by the City of Moreno Valley. During construction hours, anticipate traffic delays, detours, temporary side-street closures, lane closures, and traffic flaggers throughout the duration of the Project.
- Pedestrian access to sidewalks and bike lanes may be temporarily unavailable throughout the duration of the Project.
- Anticipate temporary noise, dust, and vibrations from construction work.
- Final paving of the affected roads along the alignment will be done at the conclusion of the Project.
- Be advised that all work is weather dependent.
- EMWD is working closely with surrounding schools, stakeholders, and the City of Moreno Valley to keep community impacts to a minimum.
