

# PERRIS BOULEVARD PIPELINE PROJECT

FALL 2023

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## PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Perris Boulevard Pipeline Project (Project) will expand the drinking water distribution system in the northern part of the City of Moreno Valley.

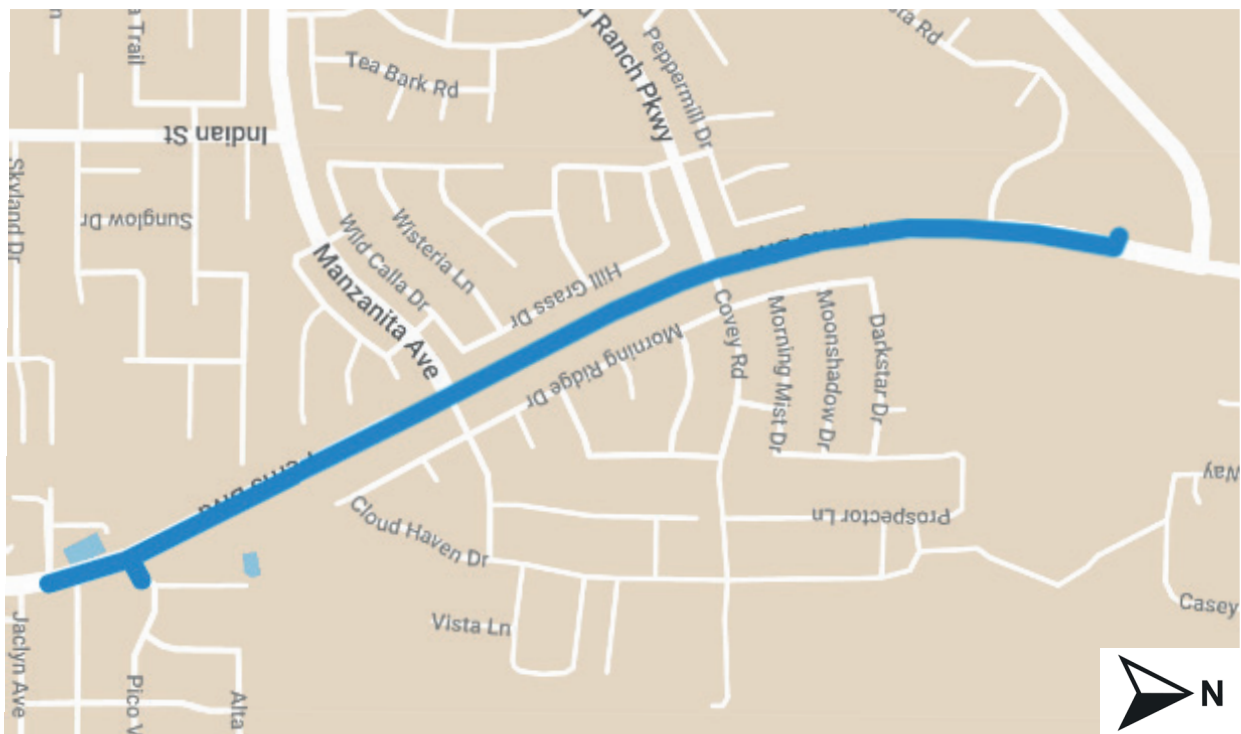
## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In Fall 2023, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) will begin work on the Project.

The Project consists of installing approximately 6,700 feet of drinking water pipeline primarily along Perris Boulevard from Robin Lane to EMWD's water storage tank located south of Heacock Street. Crews will also be working through a portion of Pico Vista Way.

The estimated completion date is Fall 2024.

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## PROJECT IMPACTS / WHAT TO EXPECT

- Current EMWD water service is not expected to be interrupted.
- Residential access will remain open at all times. Accommodated access to side-streets will be available during construction hours.
- Construction hours are set at Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. as approved by the City of Moreno Valley. There may be times when working hours temporarily change or weekend work is required to minimize traffic impacts and avoid an extended schedule duration.
- Traffic control measures will be in place. Traffic control plans are reviewed and approved by the City of Moreno Valley. Anticipate temporary traffic delays, detours, side-street closures, lane closures, temporary no-street parking, and traffic flaggers throughout the duration of the Project.
- Pedestrian access to sidewalks and bike lanes may be temporarily unavailable throughout the duration of the Project.
- Anticipate temporary noise, dust, and vibrations from construction work.
- Final paving of the affected roads along the alignment will be completed at the conclusion of the Project.
- EMWD is working closely with surrounding schools, stakeholders, and the City of Moreno Valley to keep community impacts to a minimum.
