BOARD WORK SESSION

The Board of Directors

...approved and authorized the initial study and mitigated negative declaration and consultation summary for the Temecula Valley Regional Water Reclamation Facility (TVRWRF) effluent disposal alternatives; mitigation monitoring program; and preparation and filing of the Notice of Determination. The TVRWRF provides wastewater collection, treatment, and water reclamation services for the cities of Temecula and Murrieta and portions of Riverside County. To accommodate the increasing flows and dispose of the recycled water, the District is proposing to modify the existing TVRWRF effluent pump station, install approximately 12 miles of effluent pipeline, and construct a booster pump station and a dechlorination facility. Representatives from the United States Marine Corps and Fallbrook Public Utility District expressed opposing viewpoints; a representative from Rancho California Water District spoke in support of Eastern.

Angela Carman, director of human resources management, reported on MOU proceedings. Union members will meet to discuss on June 10 and vote on June 11. It will be presented to the Board for approval on June 18.
