Board Action

In an adjourned regular meeting today, having considered the General Manager's letter of July 18, 2001 outlining his plans for retirement, the Board of Directors has determined that **John Brudin's** hard work and efforts on behalf of the District deserves recognition and reward in the following manner:

The Board accepts, with regret, the General Manager's proposal to retire, effective Dec. 31, 2001.

Effective Tues., Sept. 4, 2001, Mr. Brudin shall become Advisor to the General Manager regarding fiscal and administrative matters and to the Assistant General Manager-Resource Development regarding the Hemet/San Jacinto Groundwater Management Program, Soboba Indian negotiations and the MWD/Soboba lawsuit, and water outreach programs on an as-needed basis (full-time attendance no longer required), but at current salary and benefits levels.

Effective Jan. 1, 2002, Mr. Brudin shall serve as a consultant to the Assistant General Manager-Resource Development regarding the above-mentioned matters on an as-needed basis.

The Board hereby appoints **Anthony J. Pack** as General Manager, effective Sept. 4, 2001.
