Applications due Feb. 15, 2007

Sign-up for Eastern Municipal Water District's free landscape irrigation package

Perris, CA (January 17, 2007)— Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) is gearing up for its new residential landscape irrigation distribution event. The program, made possible through a \$50,000 grant from the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, gives qualified residential customers a free landscape irrigation package that includes an irrigation controller with a seasonal adjust feature (participants must meet certain requirements to receive this item), multi-stream rotator heads for turf grass areas only and a rain sensor.

To qualify, customers must be direct EMWD residential customers residing, for at least the past two years at the same residence, submit an application to EMWD no later than Feb. 15, and attend the mandatory, one-day-only residential irrigation distribution event on March 3.

Qualifying customers will receive a reservation number and an appointment time to attend the March 3 mandatory event. The event will be held in EMWD's Board Room at 2270 Trumble Road in Perris. There will also be 30-minute, voluntary workshops offered on the day of the event.

EMWD is the freshwater, wastewater service and recycled water provider to a 555-square mile area from Moreno Valley southward along the I-215 corridor to Temecula and eastward to Hemet and San Jacinto.
