

Public Hearing – Los Alamos Hills Water System Financing Program

Project Background

- The City of Murrieta committed to providing \$3M of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to support construction of water infrastructure for the Los Alamos Hills community
- In partnership, EMWD and the City of Murrieta entered into an Interagency Financial Contribution Agreement
 - Approved by EMWD July 6, 2022
 - Approved by Murrieta August 16, 2022
- Proposed project is a looped water system able to serve approximately 50 properties within the community with a safe, clean, and reliable water supply





Annexation in MWD and EMWD Service Areas

- Project area is located within an area of the city that is not annexed into the service areas of the Metropolitan Water District (MWD) or EMWD
 - Annexation in both water districts is required before water service can be provided
 - Annexation can occur through a dual-annexation process
- EMWD will lead annexation process and pay application processing fees
 - Fees estimated at \$19,030
- Annexation area will be determined by level of community support
 - Property owners in protest of being annexed will be excluded from the annexation application



EMWD Financing Program

- Developed to assist interested participants with the financing of the annexation costs and connection fees
 - Term: Up to 30 years (not to exceed year 2054)
 - Fixed Rate: 4.0%
 - No prepayment penalty
 - Collected annually via property tax assessments starting 2024-25 tax year
- Financing program is voluntary but only available to participants who have entered into a signed agreement with EMWD
- Estimated costs based on various parcel acreage:

Community Outreach

- September 2022 Letter
 - Mailed to property owners within the community regarding the partnership between City of Murrieta and EMWD, the project, and resources for additional information
- October 2022 Letter
 - Invited residents to a townhall meeting with the City of Murrieta and EMWD
 - Provided property-specific information with an overview of their estimated costs based on parcel size
- October 13, 2022 Townhall Meeting
 - 34 members of the community attended
 - EMWD and City of Murrieta presented information on the partnership, project information and benefits, and schedule
- Additional ongoing outreach included emails, phone calls, door hangers



Community Outreach (continued)

- November 16, 2022 EMWD Board of Directors approved financing agreement terms and set Public Hearing for December 7, 2022 to hear comments from the community
- November 22, 2022 Letters sent via Certified Mail to property owners' mailing addresses informing community of upcoming Public Hearing
- November 22, 2022 Public Notice published in The Californian
- November 24, 2022 Public Notice published in The Press-Enterprise
- November 24, 2022 Draft financing agreements sent to each property with property-specific information
- Notary signing event set for December 13, 2022
 - Notary Public also available at EMWD's main office for those unable to make signing event



Schedule

- Financing Agreements
 - Community Signing Day (Notary provided) December 13, 2022
 - Signed Agreements received by EMWD December 16, 2022
- LAFCO and Annexation Process to begin February 2023*
 - CEQA requirements completed late March early April 2023*
- Preliminary / Final Design by June 2023
- Construction Bid and Contract Award: September 2023*
- Additional Public Hearing for Annual Financing Assessments: July 2024*
 - Public Noticing to be completed in June 2024
- Construction Completion: Fall 2024
- ARPA Funding Deadline: December 2026
