Subject: EMWD Construction Update Near Your Residence – Project and No-Parking Update

Dear Neighbor:

Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) would like to provide you with an update on a project near your residence in Moreno Valley as a follow-up to the communication sent out on September 8, 2023 and on January 23, 2024.

<u>Background</u>: In April 2021, EMWD began work on a groundwater well project along <u>Los Cabos Drive, between Plaza Sonada Way and Iris Avenue, at Victoriano Park</u>. This well is an important part of our Perris North Groundwater Program, which will help provide long-term water quality and supply benefits to the region.

**Project Update**: Crews continue to work on building the structure, piping, and motors needed to operate the groundwater well. This work is anticipated to be completed by the end of the calendar year.

The community can continue to expect the following:

- Continuous and Intermittent Work on Building the Groundwater Well
  - At this time, work is happening intermittently, weather permitting. In the coming weeks, work will become more active.
- Working hours: Monday Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
  - There will be an increase in noise, dust, and vibrations due to on-site construction work during this time.
  - Please note that working days and hours can vary depending on factors such as holidays and weather conditions.
    - This means that there may be days when crews show up to the site after 7:00 a.m. and some days, crews may not show up at all.
      - This is still considered a working day at an active construction site.

**No-Parking Zone Update**: EMWD is working closely with the City of Moreno Valley to ensure that crews can access the active construction site in a safe and efficient manner during working days and hours.

The community can continue to expect the following:

- No parking along a portion of Los Cabos Drive between 6:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
  - See exhibit on the following page to see marked area for 'no parking'.
    - This is being strictly enforced until the end of the year. Enforcement is taking place Monday – Friday, no exceptions.
  - The City of Moreno Valley Code Enforcement and Police Department is and will continue
    patrolling the area to ensure compliance. EMWD is not responsible for the ticketing or towing of
    any vehicle that is not complying with the no parking signs and area as marked in the exhibit.
  - Please note that the hours for 'no parking' may differ from the working hours.

EMWD appreciates your patience and understanding as we work to complete this important project. As part of our commitment to our customers, EMWD will continue to keep you updated on the status of this work.

**IMPORTANT NOTE**: Please keep in mind that this is an active construction site. All people at the site are required to have the proper safety equipment at all times.
