ADDENDUM NO. 001 TO SPECIFICATION NO. 1365W
Hunter Tank Interior Recoating

This addendum to the specifications is for the purpose of adding, clarifying, or deleting certain information to the construction drawings and project specifications as follows:

NOTICE INVITING BID

REVISE NIB-1 as follows:

All bids submitted will become the property of EMWD and subject to disclosure under the Public Records Act. All bids will be posted on the website www.emwd.org approximately 10 days from bid opening.

P-04. Construction Drawings.

REVISE the Tank Data listed on drawing D-57742 as follows:

TANK DATA

Height: 28 Feet

Capacity: 2 MG

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Shimmick Construction

Q1. Reference Specification 09878 3.03.D – it is unclear from the contract documents provided “Appendix E” whether the existing interior coating (Walls, floors, ceiling) of the tank contain hazardous materials. Should the existing coating on interior walls, floor and ceiling be considered as having heavy metals for basis of bid?

A1. Please see Detailed Provision 00100, SC-30 below:

SC-30. Paint Samples Testing. Paint samples were taken of the tank roof exterior and interior coating around the access hatch. Test results have been included in Appendix E. Test results indicate that interior and exterior coatings contain heavy metals, including lead. As such, Contractor shall implement all heavy metal and lead abatement procedures during removal and disposal of the existing coating. See Detailed Provisions Section 09878 for additional requirements.

Due to the presence of lead in the existing coating, contractor shall comply with the requirements of Detailed Provisions Section 09878 Part 3.03 D 1 and Part 3.03 D 2.

Q2. Reference Specification 09878 3.03.D - Who is responsible for testing of interior coatings for lead?

A2. The District has performed heavy metals (CAM 17) testing of interior and exterior coatings of the tank to assist the contractor with his bid, as noted in Detailed Provision 00100, SC-30 (see above).

Per Detailed Provision 09878 D3.03.D.1:

“... All costs related to testing by the CIH shall be borne by the Contractor.”


Q3. Reference Specification 09878 3.12.A.4 – What is the estimated cost of reimbursement for rejected and drained water should the water fail the Bac-T test?

A3. The estimated cost of rejected and drained water is \$2,500.

Q4. Reference Specification 09878 3.12.A.4 – What is the estimated cost of reimbursement for rejected and drained water should the water fail the VOC and Odor test?

A4. The estimated cost of rejected and drained water is \$2,500.
