



# Perris North Groundwater Program Cactus Corridor Pipeline Project

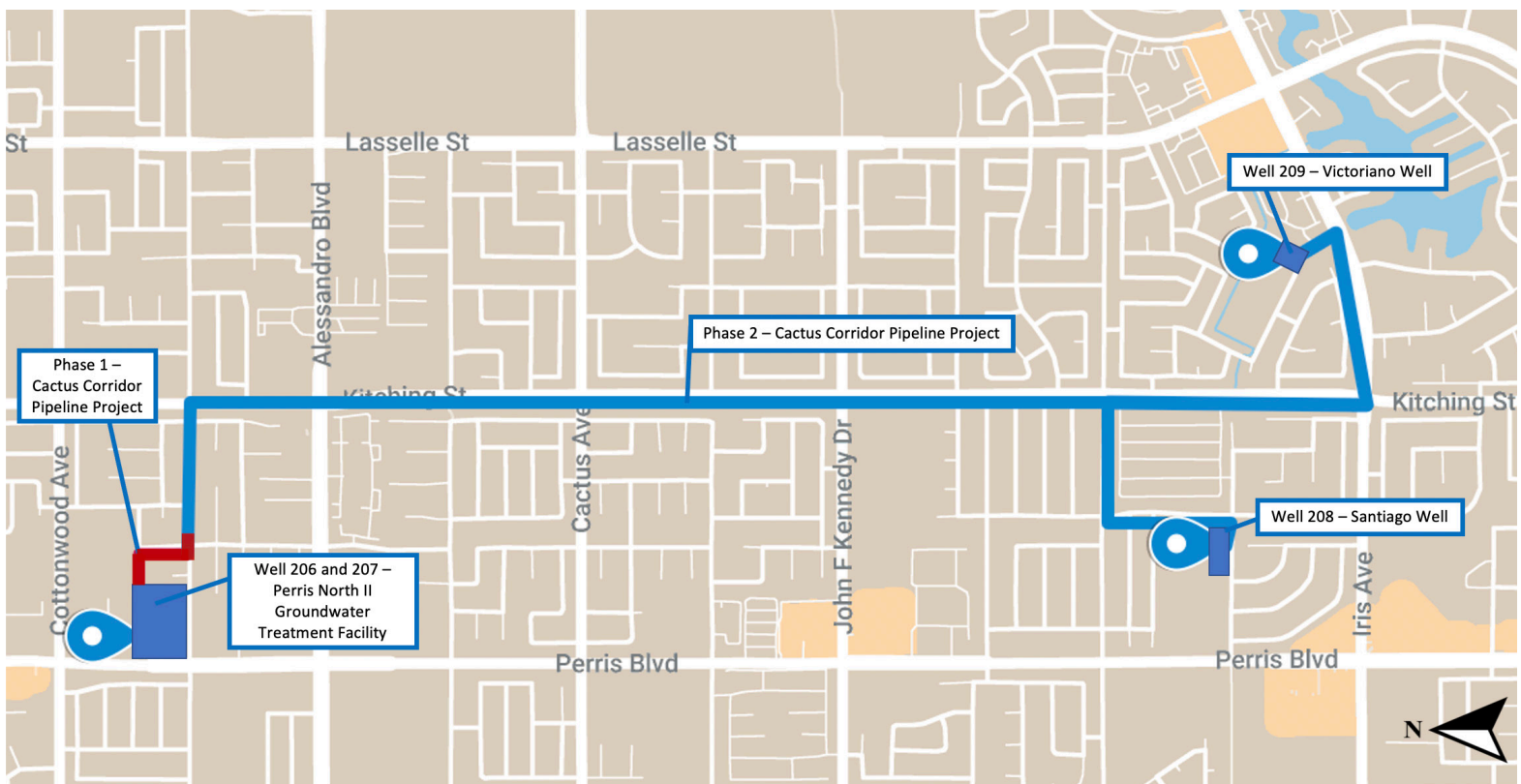
In the spring of 2021, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) will begin work on an important pipeline project as part of the Perris North Groundwater Program in the City of Moreno Valley.

The Cactus Corridor Pipeline Project will allow us to move water from the new groundwater wells in the Moreno Valley area to a planned groundwater treatment facility at Perris Boulevard and Bay Avenue.

The new pipelines will be located primarily along Kitching Street.

Construction on these pipelines is anticipated to be completed by 2023 and will be done during daytime hours. Work along Kitching Street near The Journey School, Hendrick Ranch Elementary School and along Iris Avenue near Victoriano Elementary School will be done either during summer break or with reduced working hours to accommodate school schedules.

The Perris North Groundwater Program is an important part of EMWD's Groundwater Reliability Plus initiative, which will increase our reliance on local groundwater and help our region become more sustainable, especially during periods of statewide water shortages.



## Quick Facts: Perris North Groundwater Program

- In 2020, EMWD received an agency-record \$44.9 million grant from the State Water Resources Control Board to fund approximately half of the estimated project cost for the Perris North Groundwater Program. The grant is funded through the voter-approved Proposition 1 Water Bond of 2014.
- The program will include seven groundwater wells, approximately 20 groundwater monitoring wells, a centralized treatment facility, and conveyance pipelines.
- Work on this program began in late 2020, with well drilling starting in January 2021 at the first two groundwater wells located in Northern Moreno Valley along Ironwood Avenue.
- Well construction will continue throughout 2021, with a total project completion date of mid-2023.
- The program will improve groundwater quality in the North Perris Groundwater Basin, located in the Moreno Valley area, and also increase water supply in the region.
