

Indian Street Pipeline Replacement Project

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Indian Street Pipeline Replacement Project (Project) replaces an existing water pipeline on Indian Street in the City of Moreno Valley that is nearing the end of useable life.

Estimated Project Timeline:

Start: Early 2023

End: Fall 2023

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

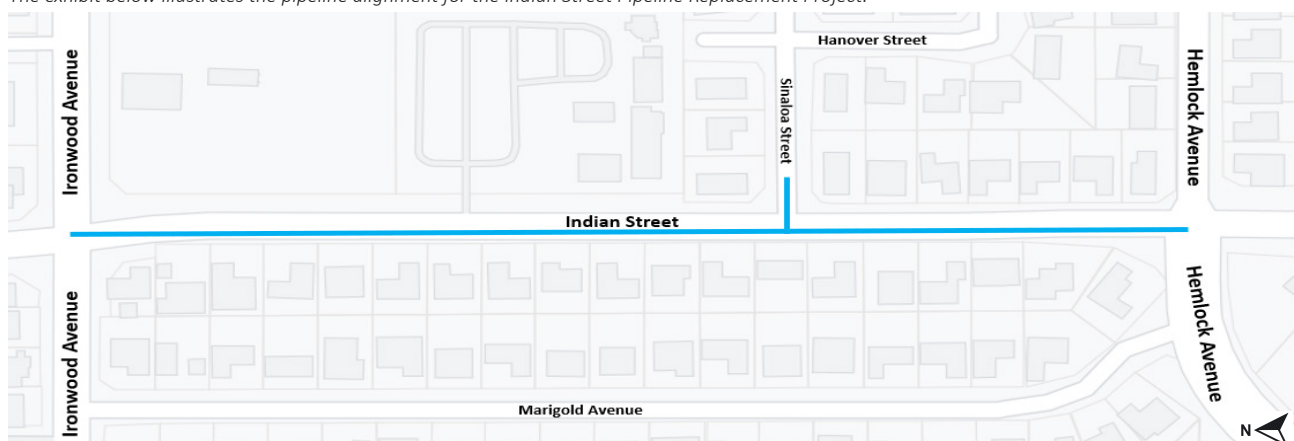
In early 2023, Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) will begin work on the Project. The Project will increase water flow and reliability for nearly 8,000 customers in the City of Moreno Valley. The estimated completion date is Fall 2023.

The Project consists of installing approximately 1,500 feet of 12-inch pipe along Indian Street between Ironwood Avenue and Hemlock Street. A map of the pipeline alignment can be seen below.

PROJECT IMPACTS/WHAT TO EXPECT (CONTINUES ON PAGE 2)

- Residential access will remain open and accommodated during construction hours. Construction hours are set at Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Traffic control measures will be in place. Traffic control plans are reviewed and approved by the City of Moreno Valley. Anticipate temporary street closures, delays, detours, temporary no-street parking, and traffic flaggers throughout the duration of the Project.

PROJECT IMPACTS/WHAT TO EXPECT (CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1)

- Anticipate temporary noise, dust, and vibrations from construction work.
- Pedestrian access to sidewalks may be temporarily unavailable throughout the duration of the Project.
- Anticipate temporary water service interruptions with advanced notice.
- New installation, replacement, and/or a shift in the location of certain fire hydrants and water meters.
- EMWD is working closely with surrounding community members and the City of Moreno Valley to keep impacts to a minimum.
