About one-third of Southern California's water supply is imported from Northern California, and much of that comes from just a few winter storms each year.

If the California WaterFix were in place in 2016, nearly half a million acre-feet of rainfall could have been captured and stored. That's enough water to supply 3.6 million people for a year. Instead, most of that water flowed into San Francisco Bay.

California WaterFix seeks to improve the ability to reliably capture some of the state's major storm events and store it in local reservoirs and groundwater basins for the Inland Empire in years of drought.
