**Subject: Mountain Avenue West Groundwater Replenishment Facility**

Dear Neighbor:

Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) would like to provide you with an update on construction activities at our Mountain Avenue West Groundwater Replenishment Facility, located at the northeast corner of Mountain and Esplanade avenues in the City of San Jacinto.

EMWD is currently on-schedule with the removal of soil materials from the facility and we anticipate that work will be completed in the spring of 2020. We appreciate your continued patience and commitment toward roadway safety in light of the extra truck traffic in the community.

As work continues with the removal of soil materials, EMWD will also begin work on drilling monitoring wells around the perimeter of the project site. These wells will be approximately 200 feet deep and will be used to monitor groundwater levels around the project site. Eight of these wells are currently planned, with drilling scheduled to begin the week of February 10, 2020, during the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays. This work will be very similar to drilling activities that have previously been conducted on the project site. As a result, residents may experience some related noise or vibrations.
