Subject: Mountain Avenue West Groundwater Replenishment Facility

Dear Neighbor:

Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) would like to provide you with an update on construction activities at our Mountain Avenue West Groundwater Replenishment Facility, located at the northeast corner of Mountain and Esplanade avenues in the City of San Jacinto.

Starting the week of February 24, 2020, our contractor will be performing work in Villines Avenue to begin installing pipelines that will provide water to the new facility. This work will be done during daytime hours on weekdays and last for several weeks. Villines Avenue will remain open for resident and visitor access during this time, but traffic control measures will be in place.

During this time, flagmen will help direct traffic flow on Villines to ensure the safety of both the community, our contractors and staff. We ask that all motorists in the area please use extra caution while driving and adhere to the traffic control systems that will be in place.
