Dear Neighbor:

On behalf of Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD), we would like to provide you with an update on construction progress on our Mountain Avenue West Groundwater Replenishment Facility in San Jacinto.

In early April, EMWD's contractor will perform pipeline work in Villines Avenue. This work is anticipated to last several days, including the installation of temporary paving on Villines. Our contractor will then return at a later date to complete the final paving restoration in accordance with both EMWD and City of San Jacinto standards. Traffic control measures will be in place during this work and EMWD asks that all motorists please adhere to the measures in place for the safety of our crews and the community.

In the coming weeks, EMWD will continue with the installation of landscaping around the project site, including ground cover. It is anticipated that the project site will be substantially complete in May, at which time our construction crews will begin demobilizing from the site.
