Subject: Murrieta Road Pipeline Project Update

Dear Neighbor:

Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) is committed to being a good neighbor and keeping you informed about ongoing activity and construction in your area. For this reason, we would like to update you on the Murrieta Road Pipeline Project taking place near your community.

This spring, EMWD began work on the first phase of the project, which required crews to tunnel under the Salt Creek Bridge to install a 42-inch diameter water line. As a result, the southbound lane of Murrieta Road was closed and detours were put in place.

Over the next week, crews will begin the process of reopening the southbound lane of Murrieta Road that crosses Salt Creek. The reopening of this lane will also see the shifting of traffic control to the south of the bridge on Murrieta Road starting at the intersection of Murrieta Road and Park City Avenue. The project is on schedule and crews will continue working to construct the pipeline southward where it will eventually connect to existing infrastructure at La Piedra Road.

We appreciate your patience during this project and thank you for using caution while driving on Murrieta Road for your safety and the safety of the crews onsite.
