


BELIEVE IT OR NOT, HUMANS HAVE ONLY BEEN AROUND FOR A SMALL AMOUNT OF THAT TIME.




IT MAKES YOU WONDER, "WHAT WAS THE FIRST THING ON EARTH?"




AT FIRST, IT WAS JUST A BIG HUNK OF ROCK.

BUT SHE WANTED TO KNOW WHAT HAD HAPPENED.





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SOON AFTER, THE SAME THING HAPPENED TO HER AGAIN!






THE MORE CLOUDS THAT FORMED,
THE HEAVIER THEY GOT. THEY BECAME DARK


— DARK WITH THE SPLASHES OF
COLOR FROM ALL THE WATER.


IN FACT, ALL THAT WATER WAS TOO HEAVY!

FIRST: EVAPORATION! THE SUN ALLOWED HER TO BECOME WATER VAPOR AND RISE.




SECOND: CONDENSATION!

SHE WAS EVER SO GRACEFULLY MOVING TO PRECIPITATION.







BUT AS SHE GREW NEARER TO THE EARTH SHE BECAME CONFUSED. SOMETHING WAS DIFFERENT.










SHE SHOWED THEM THE WATER CYCLE.


THE CREATURES ALL LOVED HER AND HER DANCE.

IN 2008, THE AWARD-WINNING WRITE-OFF PROGRAM WAS DEVELOPED BY EASTERN MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT (EMWD) EDUCATION SPECIALIST MALEA ORTLOFF, IN AN EFFORT TO ENCOURAGE A GREATER UNDERSTANDING OF OUR MOST PRECIOUS RESOURCE, WATER, IN BOTH ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS. FUNDING FOR THE WRITE-OFF CONTEST IS SPONSORED IN PART BY RANCHO CALIFORNIA WATER DISTRICT (RCWD)

THIS YEAR THE TOPIC FOCUSED ON THE WATER CYCLE AND STUDENTS WERE TASKED WITH CONVEYING A MESSAGE ABOUT HOW THE HISTORY OF THE WATER CYCLE IMPACTS OUR DAILY LIVES. MORE THAN THREE HUNDRED STUDENTS PARTICIPATED AND FOUR WINNING ENTRIES WERE SELECTED. THESE STORIES OFFER A GREAT LEARNING OPPORTUNITY FOR PEOPLE OF ALL ACES. THE STORY BOOKS ARE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES WITHIN THE EMWD/RCWD SERVICE AREAS AND ARE ALSO AVAILABLE AS EBOOKS ON THE EMWD/RCWD WERSITES.

EVAPORATION—THE TRANSFORMATION OF A LIQUID STATE TO A GASEOUS STATE BY AN INCREASE IN TEMPERATURE OR PRESSURE.

CONDENSATION—THE TRANSFORMATION OF A VAPOR OR CAS TO A LIQUID WHEN THE AIR IS VERY COLD. **Precipitation**—Rain, snow, sleet, or hall that falls to the ground.



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
