PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) is seeking funding to construct a modernized sewer system in the Temecula Valley Wine Country Region. This project will include both southern

and northern reaches of the sewer

EMWD in 2015 completed the first phase of a sewer system in Northern Wine Country, which protected groundwater quality and allowed for economic development opportunities.

Project Benefit:

Will protect groundwater quality and provide the infrastructure necessary for the anticipated economic development of Temecula's Wine Country.



Partnership Request:

EMWD is seeking funding opportunities and strategic partnership opportunities to advance the project.



Environmental Benefit:

The project will further protect groundwater quality by eliminating the need for septic systems, which leach into local groundwater supplies.



Project Financials:

Total Cost: \$28.5 million

Funding Received: \$9.1 million from the County of Riverside through the American Rescue Plan Act; \$2 million from State and Tribal Assistance Grants. Funding Requested: \$2 million from Assembly District 71.






Because of the continued expansion of wineries, restaurants and tourism, many wineries outgrew the capacities of their on-site septic systems.

The Northern Wine Country Phase II project will install 14,000 linear feet of sewer lines along Rancho California Road, Glen Oaks Road, Warren Road, and East Benton Road. The Southern Wine Country Sewer will install 23,200 linear feet of sewer line along De Anza Road and De Portola Road.

EMWD has received significant project support from the County of

Riverside, which provided \$5 million for the Northern Wine Country Phase II sewer and \$4.1 million for the Southern Wine Country sewer. It has also received \$2 million from the United States Environmental Protection Agency's State and Tribal Assistance Grants.
